The 485 m² multi-purpose hall on the ground floor, right next to the Olympic Hall, offers a quiet, intimate atmosphere. Therefore, it is particularly suitable for seminars, workshops or breakout sessions, where participants can recharge their batteries and gain new energy. When major events are hosted in the Olympic Hall, the multi-purpose hall offers a great separate venue for side events or areas for various visitor groups (e.g. children's area) – away from the hustle and bustle but yet close. Thanks to mobile partition walls, the shape and size of the multi-purpose hall can easily be adjusted. If required, it can be divided into up to four individual rooms of 65 m² to 120 m².

Later, we recommend a visit to the giant panoramic painting in the Tirol Panorama museum, which offers a fascinating 360-degree view of the third Bergisel battle in 1809.



Innsbruck's Nordkette at 2,300 m above sea level

The Innsbrucker Nordketten cable cars will take your guests right from the city centre up to the Hafelekar, the TOP OF INNSBRUCK, in just a few minutes. It is located in Austria's largest nature park, the Karwendel Nature Park. Hence, it is not unusual that visitors might catch a glimpse of the otherwise shy wild animals. The amazing 360-degree view with the Capital of the Alps on one side and the Karwendel Nature Park on the other leaves lasting impressions. Also, the Alpenzoo, Europe's highest themed zoo, is well worth a visit and easily accessible thanks to the Hungerburgbahn funicular.

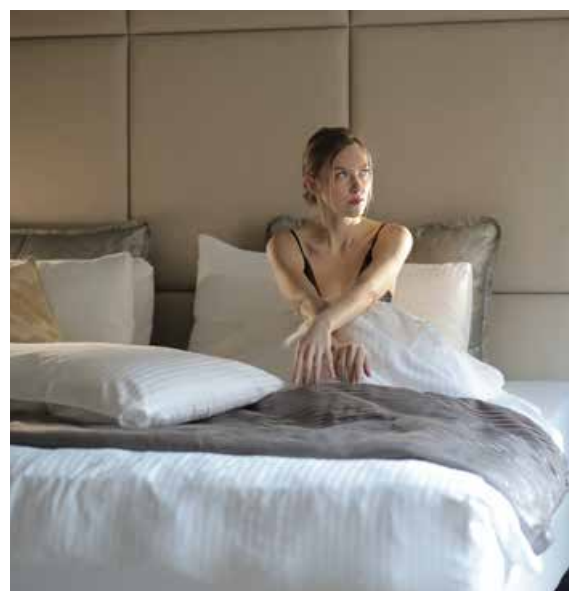

TRANSPORT CONNECTIONS OLYMPIAWORLD

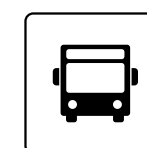
Unique infrastructure for best accessibility

Whether by airplane, car or train – there are different ways to reach Innsbruck and the Olympiaworld quickly and conveniently. With more than 1,000 parking spaces, its own motorway access, the nearby railway station and the international airport only 15 minutes away, the Olympiaworld has a unique location advantage in terms of accessibility. In Europe, there is no other event location of this size that is that easily reachable by all three important means of transport.



By plane

The international airport in the western part of Innsbruck is approached by about 50 different airlines each year. There are daily flights to Frankfurt and Vienna. The Olympiaworld is only about 15 minutes away by taxi. Alternatively, you can take the busses of the Innsbruck public transport (IVB): first bus line F, then bus line T, which runs directly to the Olympiaworld. Of course, we can also arrange a shuttle service for you.



By bus & train

The train takes you to Innsbruck main station comfortably and without stress. From there, the Olympiaworld is only a stone's throw away: five to ten minutes by taxi, depending on the traffic situation. You can also reach the Olympiaworld by public transport via the line 505. We can also organise a shuttle service for you on request.



By car

Coming from the west or east, you can reach the Olympiaworld via the A12 motorway. Take the exit Innsbruck Mitte and then follow the signs at the roundabout for the city centre (Zentrum). On the left-hand side of the main road, you will see the Tivoli football stadium and the Olympiaworld event halls.

Coming from the south, you can reach the Olympiaworld via the A13 motorway. Take the exit Innsbruck Süd and follow the main road (Brenner Bundesstraße B 182) in the direction to Innsbruck. At the intersection with Egger-Lienz-Straße, turn right. After crossing the Olympia Bridge, you will see the Olympiaworld event halls on the right-hand side of the road.



Parking facilities

The Olympiaworld area provides more than 1,000 parking spaces directly at the site; half of them in the underground car park.
